Unclean garbage boxes seem to be the problem in this area, EWM has been in receipt of employee complaints to this nature.

EWM is a transfer site only and houses no organic waste

EWM had invested in pest control for a 3 year period following the closure of the organic waste site

Sightings of rats are concentrated to a small area in the Dovkie Estates sub-division

Council will not invest in pest control until further investigation can be done.

Referred to Town Staff:

1. Check with residents in the Sheldon Drive area to gauge the number of rats
2. Call businesses on Winnonish Drive to see if they are having a rat problem
